

LIT/REP Registrations

By registering, you agree that your child will be able to attend all of the sessions in which they are applying.

Cancellation Policy:

The LIT fee includes a \$299 non-refundable/non-transferable deposit. Should the need to cancel a reservation occur, the deposit may not be applied to a future program nor to another camper. For any cancellation received NO LATER THAN 2 weeks prior to the camp arrival date, the camp fee will be refunded minus the non-refundable \$299. In order to provide the highest quality program, we must plan well in advance based on confirmed reservations. For that reason, after the 2-week deadline no refunds will be issued for cancellations. Please do not ask us to make an exception for you.

The REP fee includes a \$299 non-refundable deposit if the participant cancels prior to the start of the program. Anyone successfully completing the program (as determined by Rawhide staff) will receive a full refund including the deposit.

Health Form Requirements:

Each LIT/REP must have a recent medical form completed by a parent/guardian. Necessary health forms will be in your online account. Please complete and submit by no later than 1 week prior to the start date.

Liability Release Forms:

Each LIT/REP must have a current Liability Release Form completed by a parent/guardian on file in the ranch office during their stay. Necessary forms will be in your online account. Please complete and submit in order to complete your registration

Photography:

I understand that Rawhide Ranch may make, procure, or use photographs, films, tapes, or other likenesses of camper's physical image/voice as may be needed for use with publicity materials. Full names of campers are not used in any promotional materials.

To Bring or Not To Bring: Help us give the kids a break from their "screen time." It is important for parents to know that we do not allow the following items to be brought to camp. Any of the following items that make their way to camp with your child will be held safely in the camp office until check-out on the closing day of camp. Cell phones, iPad/iPod/MP3 players, Electronic books (Nook/Kindle/etc) , electronic games, personal sports equipment, etc. Pocketknives, slingshots, weapons, etc. Also please leave all pets/animals at home (even during check-in/check-out).

MORE IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Age Requirements:

LIT's - Must be between sophomore and junior year of high school.

REP's – Must have finished their junior year of high school and/or be 17 years old.

Must be able to attend all sessions consecutively. These dates are NOT flexible, and applicants must be available for the entirety of their program.

When Choosing a Date: Please plan to give your child the opportunity to fully participate in the camp experience rather than having to leave camp for school or doctor appointments, sports, vacation, etc. It is very disruptive to the camp program. If there is going to be a schedule conflict during your camper's stay please make camp a priority and select another session.

Bunking Request Guidelines: LIT/REP's are pre-assigned a cabin for the camp session.
